TASTING REPORT

Pédesclaux 2015 Tasting

16°C – The nose is fairly closed and fresh, with restrained aromas of red berries, sweet spices, and a delicate floral freshness. The palate opens with vibrant acidity and evolves with tension toward a firm finish with slight dryness.

16.5°C – The nose opens up and becomes more expressive, showing attractive mineral freshness along with juicy red berries (blackcurrant) and spice. The palate is rounder and more generous, with more noticeable yet slightly grainy tannins. The finish is fairly short but lively and savory.

17°C – The bouquet is complex and fully expressive, revealing blackcurrant, sweet spices, and flinty mineral notes. The wine is elegant, seductive, and refined. The palate is well-balanced, round, generous, and vibrant, with a silky texture, fine tannins, and a long, aromatic finish.

17.5°C – The nose begins to close, while still offering notes of caramel and candied fruit. The palate feels heavier and shorter. Oak tannins become more pronounced and slightly grainy.

| We selected 17°C as the ideal serving temperature for Château Pédesclaux 2015.

Lilian Ladouys 2016 Tasting

16°C – The nose is closed and muted, showing very little aromatic expression. The palate is tight, lacking breadth and volume, with a short, slightly drying finish.

16.5°C – The nose remains rather closed but develops more appealing aromas of fresh dark berries and charcoal. It remains attractive and inviting. The palate is fresh and lively, finishing with firm structure and slightly rough tannins.

17°C – The nose is open, expressive, and highly appealing, featuring juicy black fruit and cocoa powder. The palate is fresh, complex, and generous, leading to a long finish with fine, silky tannins.

17.5°C – The nose remains open with lightly caramelized dark berries and dry oak notes. The palate is rich, broad, and dense with excellent complexity. The tannins are more pronounced, chalky, and slightly sticky. The finish is long, warm, and almost reminiscent of capsaicin.

| We selected 17°C as the ideal serving temperature for Château Lilian Ladouys 2016.
